

ULTIMATE NEWZEALAND 11 DAYS TOUR

(Departure date: Wednesday, 5/15/25 per month)

Day 1: Auckland/Waitomo/Rotorua (L/D)



07:30 Departs Auckland SKY CITY. Travel south over the Bombay Hills into the rich farmland of the Waikato region. Passing through Ngaruawahia and on the Waitomo Caves. Waitomo Glowworm Caves, a network of underground tunnels and caves made from incredible limestone formations. Set off on a 45-minute guided tour of the caves, ending with a truly special boat trip through the Glowworm Grotto, where glowworms twinkle and shine overhead as you sail through a dark and silent cavern. After lunch we go to hobbiton movie set. The Hobbiton Movie Set has become one of New

Zealand's must-see destinations. A working farm near the small town of Matamata was transformed into a film set for the world-famous Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit movies, and today you can visit the set and see where the magic was created. After visit hobbiton movie set, we will go to Rotorua.

Stay: IBIS Hotel Rotorua or Same Class

Day 2: Rotorua/Taupo/Palmerston north (B/L/D)

After having breakfast in hotel, depart to Whakarewarewa to see the wood carving, weaving and the thermal valley with the famous roaring geysers and mud pools. Visit the entertaining Agrodome Farm Show, with 19 breads of Sheep, Sheep auction, sheep dog demonstration and sheep shearing by a top shearer, hand milk a cow or deed baby lambs. Then visit Te puia, along with access to the world famous Pohutu geyser, visitors have an opportunity to see Māori cultural performances (optional), live kiwi, boiling mud pools, native bush and the National Schools of Wood Carving and Weaving.



These are the threads that form the fabric of Te Puia, fitting its role as kaitiaki (guardian) of Māori culture for future generations. At the noon, we will take a ride in Rotorua's iconic Skyline Gondola and eat seafood buffet lunch in a beautiful restaurant. After lunch, we will go to Palmerston north via Lake Taupo.

Stay: Copthorne hotel Palmerston north or same class

Day 3 Palmerston north / Wellington (B/L/D)



After breakfast, Travel to Wellington, New Zealand's capital city. Arrive early enough for a visit to the National Museum, Te Papa. Take a short walk from our accommodation to see the sights of the central business district. Take in a beautiful 360° view of Wellington from Mount Victoria, experience the rugged South Coast, and explore quaint villages throughout the city.

Stay: Ibis Wellington or CQ Hotel or same class

DAY 4 Wellington /Christchurch/Greymouth (B/L/D)

In the morning, we depart to the south island's largest population center -Christchurch by airplane. Arriving Christchurch by flight. A brief stop in Christchurch for a tour of Avon River, art Museum, Memorial Bridge, church Square. After Lunch , we will depart to Greymouth and pass through magnificent landscapes ranging from the lush pasture land of the Canterbury Plains to the rugged gorges and pristine ice-fed streams and lakes of the Southern Alps.

Pick up at Christchurch Airport at 10 am and 2 pm, please meet the group at Greymouth if you could not get together on time.

Stay: Kingsgate hotel Greymouth or same class



DAY 5 Greymouth/Hasst (B/L/D)



Visit Paparoa National Park for an amazing limestone landscape. The PANCAKE ROCKS, the layered rock formations of Panakaiki, will certainly give you an unforgettable experience. Travel down West Coast toward Hokitika, famous for its local cuisine and Greenstone, where we stop for lunch and visit to the Jade Factory. The traces of gold rush that brought thousands to the area in 1800s are still evident in the historic town of ROSS, where we stop for Gold Panning. depart for Fox Glacier to enjoy the native rainforest and spectacular scenery encapsulates the west coast.

Stay: Hasst world heritage hotel or same class

DAY6: Hasst/Queenstown (B/L/D)

After breakfast in hotel, we will depart to Queenstown via Lake Wanaka. See the snowcapped peaks of the Southern Alps as you continue via the Haast Pass, an area of stunning beauty before arriving into picturesque Queenstown, a year-round resort situated on the shores of magical Lake Wakatipu. In the evening, we will take a ride in Queenstown's iconic Skyline Gondola to experience unforgettable view.

Stay: Mercure hotel Queenstown or same class



Day 7: Queenstown (B)



Free day for your own activities. Suggested optional tour: Jet boat, Bungy Jump, 18 Century steamboat ...You can board the vintage steamship TSS Earnslaw and cruise across Lake Wakatipu to Walter Peak Station. Sit back, relax and enjoy a delicious gourmet barbecue dinner featuring a menu of seasonal, fresh and locally sourced food at the Colonel's Homestead.

Stay: Mercure hotel Queenstown or same class

Day 8: Queenstown/Milford sound / Te anau(B/L/D)

Depart Queenstown for a fascinating drive to Milford Sound where you board your launch for a cruise on this magnificent fiord. See the spectacular Bowen Falls and towering Mitre Peak as you enjoy a picnic lunch onboard. After cruise, we will depart to most beautiful town –Te anau . You may like to visit the Glow Worm Caves where you can admire the incredible limestone caverns, waterfalls and mystery of the Glow Worm Grotto (optional).



Stay: Distinction Te Anau Hotel & Villas or same class

Day 9 Te anau/Dunedin /Oamaru (B/L/D)



In the morning, we depart to Dunedin. Visit Dunedin, New Zealand’s oldest city featuring the history, the scenery and the wildlife encounters. Otago University , Historical Railway Station, World’s most vertical Street are must stops. Visit the perfectly spherical Moeraki Boulder which are believed to be 60 million years old. Overnight in Oamaru for Penguin Parade. Don't forget to check out the harbor and the Oamaru Blue Penguin Colony – a must see attraction.

Stay: Brydone hotel Oamaru or Heritage court motel or same class

Day10 Oamaru/Mt cook /Tekapo (B/D)

Through the high-country landscape of the Mackenzie Basin arriving at Mt Cook Village, where you can gaze up at the 3,724m spectacles of Aoraki / Mt Cook. It’s a short distance to Lake Tekapo. Its patchwork of agricultural activity ranges from grazing grass and wheat to herbs and sunflowers.



Stay: The godley hotel or same class

Day 11 Tekapo / Christchurch (B/L)



In the morning, view the tiny Church of the Good Shepherd and the Collie Dog Memorial overlooking Lake Tekapo before coming back to Christchurch. Depart to Christchurch, if you are lucky, you will see alpaca before finishing the tour. Take the flight back to Auckland from Christchurch Airport.
